Training Details

(Description of post)

This post is suitable for those who wish to undertake specialist training in orthodontics and will prepare the individual for the Membership in Orthodontics examination of the Royal Colleges. The post offers broad experience in all aspects of orthodontics and provides an exciting opportunity to be involved in providing orthodontic services to the local community. Duties include clinical sessions, and involvement in teaching and mentoring more junior staff. The post holder will be expected to treat a range of patients in accordance with departmental guidelines. The post holder will be encouraged to develop their clinical skills and progress in the post, taking on increasingly complex patients and caseload. Whilst service delivery is important, contributions to the wider Trust/s in fields such as audit, outcomes, research management and teaching will be encouraged.

This StR1-3 post in orthodontics will rotate alternate weeks between the orthodontic departments at the William Harvey Hospital, Ashford, Kent (East Kent University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust) and Guy's and St Thomas' NHS foundation trust within the Faculty of Dentistry, Oral & Craniofacial Sciences at King's College London. There will be 6 clinic sessions a week, 5 of which are personal treatment under supervision. The remaining session will be on a new patient clinic. The remaining sessions will be for admin/research/ audit plus Friday mornings when they will be expected to attend the Greater London Lecture Program. The successful applicant will be expected to manage and organize their own clinics and undertake an audit project. They will receive fully nursing, technical and secretarial support.

Duties and Responsibilities of postholder

Duties of post

- Treatment of patients with a range of malocclusions using a variety of appliance systems to a high standard under the supervision of the Consultant.
- Organisation of and participation in the Consultant clinics and multidisciplinary clinics.
- The appointee is expected to undertake research and the publication of scientific literature is encouraged.
- Participation in the organisation and administration of the department, including contributions to departmental and regional audit, journal club, department meetings.
- Teaching and supervision of postgraduates and undergraduates in both a formal and non-formal capacity.



Description of main training site

East Kent University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust

The position is based in the Maxillofacial Unit at the William Harvey Hospital, Ashford, Kent. This hospital is located on the outskirts of Ashford 2 miles from the Ashford International Station, with high speed trains running regularly from St Pancras, taking only 38 minutes, and adjacent to the M20, junction 10. The Maxillofacial Unit is a self-contained department with purpose built facilities. It was completed in March 2011 and comprises a reception area, 6 single clinical rooms and a four chair poly clinic. There is a 2 bay recovery area, full radiographic facilities including Cone Beam CT and a state of the art in-house laboratory. The department is moving towards becoming fully digital with access for the trainee to Dolphin Imaging, 3D model and intra-oral scanning.

The successful applicant will work in a busy polyclinic with 2 orthodontic therapists under the supervision of Mr. Andrew DiBiase, Mr Gavin Power and Miss Arti Hindocha, Consultants in Orthodontics. There are monthly multi-disciplinary surgical, restorative and cleft joint clinics with opportunities to attend main theatre operating lists for restorative and orthognathic patients. The department has 5 full time Maxillofacial Consultants as well as a 2 Restorative Consultants.

There are multiple trainees in Maxillofacial Surgery, Restorative Dentistry as well as a post-CCST orthodontic specialist training post linked to the Royal London Dental Hospital. There are weekly tutorials and opportunities for teaching/training. The orthodontic unit has a proven track record of award-winning research with excellent opportunities for collaborative studies.



Description of second training site
