It has c 1300 beds and serves up to 3.5 million people across the SW of England.</p> <p>We get a total of 3000 referral per year and these are dealt with in hospital based clinics over the two main hospital sites in the Trust, (St. George's and Queen Mary's Roehampton) All interventions are undertaken, again at both sites on every day of the working week and Saturdays..</p> <p>.In addition to usual interventions, please mention: RACZ and US guided procedures are undertaken by leaders in their field. Trigeminal ganglionolysis is undertaken on site.</p> |
