

Full set of questions asked in a consultant interview

1. Tell me about career/training to date
2. Why do you want this job (or to work here/in this department)?
3. What is your vision for this department and what will you do to achieve this?
4. Tell me about a patient safety incident and discuss your involvement- (in-phase report/learning/governance
5. Follow up question: do you think systems-based learning about incidents has a role in managing NHS safety incidents?
6. EDI - what will you do as consultant to promote EDI?
7. What's your most significant research output to date and why ?
8. Nursing colleague has been verbally abused by patient, how would you approach/what would you do?
9. Role of x in y era (clinical question)
10. Colleagues talking about you on the bus - what would they say (after saying positive things- asked if anything negative)
11. Recent paper that's had an impact on you and why?
