FDs will be asked to review online information about the Educational Supervisors &amp; their practices. Indications of ranked preference of practices will then be made by the FD and used in the allocation process in national ranking</p>

<p><b>Overview</b></p>	<p>The Scheme is aiming high and works hard to provide excellent resources and very highly regarded lecturers for the study day programme. For most Study Days we meet at the Deakin Learning Centre in the Addenbrookes Hospital Biomedical Campus, which is situated in south Cambridge. Some of the study day sessions provided are practical hands-on experiences with many taking place in the first term, creating opportunities to question some of the best minds in Foundation Training on a one-to-one basis. These take place at Ipswich Hospital Postgraduate Centre which has high quality teaching rooms and an on-site simulation suite with a hands-on room equipped with the latest phantom heads.</p> <p>Feedback and reflection are encouraged from both Foundation Dentists and Educational Supervisors to ensure progressive development of the Scheme curriculum and to assist forward planning of future educational events. Most of our Educational Supervisors are either actively facilitating or supporting the Day Release Course sessions throughout the year.</p> <p>The scheme actively encourages an open and lively approach to the training year and will ensure that all individual learning needs are supported. The TPD is keen to ensure that Foundation Dentists are fully equipped to deal with life in General Dental Practice on completion of a successful and enjoyable Foundation year.</p>
