The study day programme continues to evolve each year but is planned around the national DFT curriculum.

Normally, the year starts with a hands-on study day so you can reintroduce yourself to some common aspects of everyday practice after a summer break. In addition to this, there are hands-on days covering endodontics, dentures, medical emergencies, TMD examinations, direct & indirect restorations and communication skills.

The study days complement the rest of the week, when you are the working in practice, with a range of speakers including experienced General Dental Practitioners, Specialists and Consultants.

The overarching ethos of the FD study days is FD participation, problem solving, and developing the confidence to work within small informal groups.

All Health Education England North West FDs are encouraged to consider the MFDS examination in their early years.
