of everyday practice after a long summer break. In addition to this, there are hands-on days covering endodontics, the use of facebows, TMD examinations, denture duplication and communication skills.

The study days complement the rest of the week, when you are the working in practice, with a range of speakers including experienced General Dental Practitioners, Specialists and Consultants.

The overarching ethos of the FD study days is FD participation, problem solving, and developing the confidence to work within small informal groups.

All Health Education England North West FDs are encouraged to consider the MJDF examination in their early years.
