Description of training post	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are learning opportunities in inpatient & day case theatres, ITU & high dependency unit, wards, outpatients department, minor injuries unit, and specialist clinics, as appropriate. These include Orthognathic and Head & Neck Cancer MDTs as well as acute involvement with Trauma patients. You will have the opportunity to develop your surgical skills in LA and some GA procedures. You will also have the chance to develop a more holistic approach to patient care on the wards & in theatres. Some of your teaching/training will come from appropriately trained Associate Specialists & Staff Grades as well as Consultants and their StR trainees• In addition to the formal opportunities identified through the curriculum, opportunities may also arise in the post to gain experience teaching and supervising, and to participate in audits, research and quality improvement work.• This post will provide exposure within the generality of the specialty of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, with particular

emphasis on dento-alveolar surgery, Orthognathic surgery, salivary gland surgery, trauma & surgical dermatology.

- There will be opportunities to ascend the Orthognathic MDT clinics with Orthodontists and Surgeons.
- Consultant and Specialty Doctor clinics will provide exposure to a range of commonly encountered Oral Medicine and Oral Surgery conditions. These diagnostic and management skills will stand the trainee in good stead for their future career in primary or secondary care.
- The trainee will have supervised opportunities to perform minor oral surgery procedures including surgical exodontia and mucosal biopsies under local anaesthetic (LA) and in theatre under general anaesthesia (GA), with a view to eventually developing the skills and confidence to undertake their own LA list later in the year.
- LA skin lists and elective operating lists (Orthognathic / Head & Neck oncology / Salivary / Trauma) will provide supervised opportunities to perform wound closure.
- With the support of supervising senior clinicians on call duties will enable the trainee to develop knowledge and skills in the management of commonly encountered OMFS emergency presentations (lacerations / dento-alveolar trauma / bony trauma / infections). Furthermore on-call duties will provide experience in holistic peri-operative inpatient care, with opportunities to develop skills in venepuncture and cannulation.
- All trainees will be encouraged and supported to undertake clinical audit, with opportunities to undertake clinical research and present works at loco-regional and national meetings.
- Previous DCTs have been successful in securing Specialty Doctor posts (many in house), Specialty Training posts and medical school posts.

12.	<p>Pattern of working including any on-call commitment</p> <p><i>Dra% Timetable</i></p>	<p>The working pattern is a full shift rota based over a cycle of 10 weeks and includes the following:</p> <p>30 standard shifts (0800-1800). Normally this will involve attending clinics, the wards, the Minor Injuries Unit and the operating theatre.</p> <p>7 late nights (1330-2230) this involves providing emergency cover</p> <p>7 long shifts, 2 of which are worked at the weekend (0800-2030). This involves providing emergency cover and supporting the Minor Injuries Unit.</p> <p>Your contract is full-time based on 40 hours. Additionally you will be contracted for 7.11 additional hours, making a total contracted hours of 47.11 (adjusted for both annual and study leave). Average weekly hours paid at the basic rate are 37 Average weekly hours attracting a 37% enhancement are 10.11</p> <p><i>Note: These figures are the average weekly hours, based on the length of your rota cycle, as required by Schedule 2 of the Terms and Conditions of Service.
