It is usually the case that a higher proportion of practices are based around the Greater Belfast area however there is usually representation in rural areas.			
<b>Local Allocation Process followed in 2020</b>	Northern Ireland received the list of successful applicants allocated to the scheme in July 2020. A ranking form was sent to all applicants allocated to the Northern Ireland scheme with details of the appointed			

<p><b>(This may be subject to alteration for 2022).</b></p>	<p>Educational Supervisors/practices and information on each one.</p> <p>Allocation Process - The Foundation Dentist with the highest score from the National recruitment process will be allocated their first choice of Educational Supervisor. This training opportunity is then removed from the allocations process.</p> <p>The next highest scoring trainee will be given their first preference if it is still available. If not, their next available preference will be offered and so on until an allocation has been made. This process is applied to all Foundation Dentists until all training placements are filled or the list of Foundation Dentists is exhausted.</p> <p>Following allocation the main scheme is split into three sub-schemes and an Adviser is allocated to each scheme.</p>
