

Your TPDs are working with the HET officers to confirm the list of trainees who will have a January ARCP, and trainees will receive an individual email with the date, as soon as this work has been completed. However, we can provide you with the January dates to help you in your preparations.

Please note that all ARCPs will remain in absentia.

The school website has a lot of useful information about preparing for your ARCP together with links to the necessary documentation in the resource section. We will be using the RCOA National Anaesthetic ARCP checklist for all LSA ARCPs again.

Please remember to submit one ESSR for your ARCP for the full period under review where the start date is the day following on from the end date set for your previous ARCP.

The Form R must also cover the entire period from the date of your last FORM R to this one. You must include all periods of time out of training in your TOOT declaration. This includes OOPC, OOPE, OOPR (if not being counted for training) and maternity/paternity leave.

We are holding an ARCP workshop on the 6/12/22 from 09.30am. This is open to all trainees and will be online. We are hoping to cover an overview of the ARCP process, preparing for your ARCP and RCOA documents you need to know, during the session with lots of time for a Q&A too. Dr Oliver Rose and hopefully Dr Rene Suite, who are our South London RAAs will be joining me.

We will also be running another session nearer the summer ARCPs too, so feel free to wait until then if you know your ARCP is later in your training year.

Summer 2023 windows are being finalised and exceptions are now being requested, final confirmation of these requests will be confirmed in early November. Therefore, we plan to release all confirmed dates along with panel links to register before Christmas. Please note most trainees will be reviewed in window 1 which will be in May 2023.

## <u>00Ps</u>

The next round of OOPs will be reviewed in the November Panel on 14th November 2022. Trainees will hear in due course following the panel review.

If you are considering a period of OOP, please discuss this with your Training Programme Director and Educational Supervisor as early as possible, before you make an application.

You must give at least 6-month's notice in advance of the proposed OOP start date. This is in order to meet the Code of Practice requirements.
