Training Details

(Description of post)

This post is suitable for those who wish to undertake specialist training in orthodontics and will prepare the individual for the Fellowship in Orthodontics examination of the Royal Colleges.

The post offers broad experience in all aspects of orthodontics and provides an exciting opportunity to be involved in providing orthodontic services to the local community.

Duties include clinical sessions, and involvement in teaching and mentoring more junior staff. The post holder will be expected to treat a range of patients in accordance with departmental guidelines.

The post holder will be encouraged to develop their clinical skills and progress in the post, taking on increasingly complex patients and caseload.

Whilst service delivery is important, contributions to the wider Trust/s in fields such as audit, outcomes, research management and teaching will be encouraged.

Duties and Responsibilities of postholder

Main duties and responsibilities

The appointed candidate will be expected to:

1. Active involvement in new patient clinics for the advice, diagnosis and treatment planning of patients referred into the departments.
2. Treat a wide range of malocclusions, including Multidisciplinary cases (Orthognathic/ minor oral surgery/ Restorative and Paediatric Dentistry)
3. Attend and participate in the running of MDT clinics
4. Active involvement and attendance at tutorials, lectures, journal clubs and organised teaching.
5. Undertake an active role in Research within the department.

Description of main training site

Barts Health NHS Trust

With a turnover of £1.25 billion and a workforce of 15,000, Barts Health is the largest NHS trust in the country, and one of Britain's leading healthcare providers serving a population of 2.5 million in east London and beyond. The trust, established on 1 April 2012, consists of six local hospital sites: Mile End Hospital, The London Chest Hospital, The Royal London Hospital, Newham University Hospital, St Bartholomew's Hospital and Whipps Cross University Hospital. Barts Health is also proud to be part of UCL Partners, Europe's largest and strongest academic health science partnership. The objective of UCL Partners is to translate cutting edge research and innovation into measurable health gain for patients and populations through partnership across settings and sectors, and through excellence in education. The Royal London is a leading, internationally renowned teaching hospital based in east London offering a full range of local and specialist services, which includes one of the largest children's hospitals in the UK with one of London's busiest paediatric Accident and Emergency departments. Home to London's air ambulance, The Royal London is also one of the capital's leading trauma and emergency care centres and hyper-acute stroke centres. The Royal London provides district general hospital services for the City and Tower Hamlets and specialist tertiary care services for patients from across London and elsewhere. It is also the base for the HEMS helicopter ambulance service, operating out of a specially built roof area. There are 675 beds, 110 wards and 26 operating theatres at The Royal London Hospital. The new building opened in February 2012 and is the largest stand-alone acute hospital building in Europe.

The Department of Orthodontics

The Department is grouped with the Department of Paediatric Dentistry with clinical facilities on the 1st Floor of the 'new' state of the art Dental Hospital opened in April 2014. The Orthodontic Department provides specialist training for an annual intake of 5-6 Postgraduate Students/Specialist Registrars on a 3 years training programme. The Department therefore has 15-17 Postgraduate Students in Orthodontics. The clinics are equipped with up-to-date clinical facilities and are fully computerised arranged as a modern polyclinic.

A dedicated room has been allocated for trainees with desk space and computers that can be used for digitisation or radiographs and tracing of radiographs. There is also a laser scanning room that is part of the Oral Biometrics laboratory and clinical scientist support.

Description of second training site

Ashford Hospital

Ashford Hospital, situated on the A30 to the west of London, close to the junction 13 of the M25 and Heathrow Airport is part of Ashford and St. Peter's NHS Trust.

The hospital continues to provide a wide range of medical and mainly day surgical services, outpatients services, ophthalmology, a dedicated stroke rehabilitation unit and now includes the Ashford Health Centre and Rapid Access Centre.

The main centres of population served by the hospital are Ashford, Staines, Sunbury, Shepperton, Feltham, Hanworth, Bedfont, Hampton, Teddington, Wraysbury and Heathrow Airport.

With the recent closure of the West Wing, all the wards and departments are located in buildings opened in 1995. The Education Centre is in the newest part of the building and provides a focus for training activities in the hospital, including a well-equipped library with computerised access, and a state of the art lecture theatre.
