# Barts Health NHS Trust

With a turnover of £1.25 billion and a workforce of 15,000, Barts Health is the largest NHS trust in the country, and one of Britain's leading healthcare providers serving a population of 2.5 million in east London and beyond. The Royal London is a leading, internationally renowned teaching hospital based in east London offering a full range of local and specialist services, which includes one of the largest children's hospitals in the UK with one of London's busiest paediatric Accident and Emergency departments. Home to London's air ambulance, The Royal London is also one of the capital's leading trauma and emergency care centres and hyper-acute stroke centres. The Royal London provides district general hospital services for the City and Tower Hamlets and specialist tertiary care services for patients from across London and elsewhere. It is also the base for the HEMS helicopter ambulance service, operating out of a specially built roof area. There are 675 beds, 110 wards and 26 operating theatres at The Royal London Hospital. The new building opened in February 2012 and is the largest stand alone acute hospital building in Europe.

#### The Department of Orthodontics

The Department is grouped with the Department of Paediatric Dentistry with clinical facilities on the 1st Floor of the Dental Hospital. The Orthodontic Department provides specialist training for an annual intake of 5-8 Postgraduate Students/Specialist Registrars on a 3-year training programme. The Department therefore houses 15-20 Postgraduate Students in Orthodontics. The department was completely refurbished in March 2017 as part of a new build with up-to-date clinical facilities arranged as a modern polyclinic.

A dedicated room has been allocated for Dolphin analysis, digitization or radiographs, tracing of radiographs and clinical photography. There is also a laser scanning room on the that is part of the Oral Biometrics laboratory, and clinical scientist support.

## Description of second training site

Whipps Cross University Hospital is an NHS Hospital in Waltham Forest, North East London serving a local population of more than 350,000 people. It is part of Barts Health NHS Trust which was created on 1st April 2012 following the merger of Barts and The London NHS Trust, Newham University Hospital NHS Trust and Whipps Cross University Hospital NHS Trust. The area served is vibrant and diverse with a wide variation of levels of health needs.

The Orthodontic Department is adjacent to the Oral Maxillo-facial Surgery Department, with which it shares many facilities. The Department has a dedicated polyclinic, which includes three dental units and a fourth separate clinic. There is a separate sterilising area, junior staff office / planning area, laboratory, model store, staff room, waiting area and offices.

The Department provides a full range of contemporary Orthodontic techniques and adopts an interdisciplinary approach to patient care. Regular Combined Clinics are held with Oral and Maxillo-facial Surgery and there is access to the many services available at the Royal London Hospital with which we are merged.

There is a dedicated postgraduate dental conference, teaching and training area in close proximity to the Department. Whipps Cross Hospital also has a very active postgraduate Medical Education Centre.
