If less than full time may not be able to progress to next stage despite satisfactory if not completed time for training. In these cases, CCT calculator important e.g. can get outcome 1 when completed 36 months as 0.6 LTFT i.e. 21.6 month full time equivalent but near end of ST2 and only progresses to ST3 when completed 24 months full time equivalent
